Durham Meadoway open house

The Regional Municipality of Durham is inviting residents to attend the final Durham Meadoway open house. Community input has already helped shape the project vision, develop guiding principles, identify a preferred route and create a programming concept plan. Join the project team at the final open house to learn more and share your input.

Durham Meadoway is a proposed pedestrian and cycling route and linear park that will connect people to destinations across more than 30 km of Durham Region. In addition to providing a significant east-west recreational facility and active transportation spine for cycling and other activities, the Durham Meadoway has the potential to become a multi-faceted space for people that includes ecological enhancements, public art and community amenities.

There will be short presentations by the project team at 6:20 and 7:20 p.m.

Why: The Region is working with stakeholders and the community to develop a visioning study for the Durham Meadoway. The visioning study will provide a robust vision and framework that will guide future detailed planning and implementation of the corridor. The visioning study is the first of several initiatives that will be needed to take the Durham Meadoway from concept to construction.

Platinum-selling singer/songwriter **Lee Brice** has announced his tour with special guests **Tenille Arts** and **Josh Ross**, hitting arenas across Canada this spring including Oshawa's Tribute Communities Centre on Friday, April 28, 2023.

About Lee Brice:

When Curb Records recording artist, Lee Brice, isn't selling out arenas, writing and recording songs, or building new brands like American Born whiskey, you'll find the family man with his wife Sara, two young boys, and daughter. Meanwhile, with over 3.7 billion on-demand streams, and over 3.6 billion spins on Pandora, Brice continues to enjoy massive success at country radio, digital streaming services, and on the road. He recently reached #1 at Country Radio with Platinum-selling "Memory I Don't Mess With," which consecutively follows three prior #1s: ASCAP's 2021 Country Song of the Year and 3x Platinum track "One of Them Girls," "I Hope You're Happy Now" with Carly Pearce, and "Rumor," which was nominated in the category Single of the Year at the 55th Annual ACM Awards. One of the most-played country artists of all time on Pandora, he was the second country artist behind Keith Urban to receive the Pandora Billionaire plaque. Lee is also a GRAMMY nominee, a CMA and ACM award winner, and he's taken nine radio singles to Number One: "A Woman Like You," "Hard to Love," "I Drive Your Truck," "I Don't Dance," "Drinking Class," "Rumor," "I Hope You're Happy Now," "One of Them Girls," and "Memory I Don't Mess With." Garth Brooks, Jason Aldean, Kenny Chesney and others h

ave recorded his songs, and he's performed on numerous TV shows, including NBC's Today, ABC's The Bachelor, NBC's The Voice and FOX's Miss USA 2018. Lee performed as part of the Library of Congress Gershwin Prize for Popular Song honoring Garth Brooks, aired on PBS March of 2020. At the 54th Annual CMA Awards, Lee took home the prize for Musical Event of the Year for his song with Carly Pearce, "I Hope You're Happy Now." At the 56th ACM Awards, "I Hope You're Happy Now" won Single of the Year and Music Event of the Year, and Lee and Carly Pearce performed the song live. Lee's latest album, Hey World, features current radio single "Soul."
