The original idea for the band started about 10 years ago when Simon Head (Bass/ backing vocals) and Mikey Hawdon (rhythm guitar) were in a Skype conversation. Simon noticed that Mikey was wearing a 3/4 sleeve Huey Lewis & the News shirt and gushed over how that was his first unchaperoned concert and how much the "Sports" album meant to him. Simon then suggested that they re-record that album at his Insight Recording studio note for note and cut for cut. A week or two went by when Mikey called Simon saying he had learned all the drum parts and was ready to record. What started off as an extemporaneous remark began a project that never ended.

The project moved from hard drive to hard drive, computer to computer until one day in the spring of 2019, The Power of Huey became a reality!
